
Things that could be better in the sanctuary . . .

- Ability to work around the sides, especially to accommodate musicians. Music is a foundation of our worship services and we're doing a larger variety of things than before. Accommodate smaller gatherings and events in a more flexible way.
- Provide better accommodation of peoples' mobility needs. Wheelchairs, walkers, etc.
 - Increase our aisle space and be able to create open spots where we want.
 - Add steps and railings at sides of altar

Things that could be better in the sanctuary . . . (continued)

- Provide better ability to move in and out of pews. They're tightly spaced, and a few extra inches would make them more accessible.
- Have more space in front. It's squeezed now for funerals, musicians, communion.
- Comfort


