## Why consider serving as a member of the Synodical Board of Women of the ELCA?

The constitution of Women of the ELCA, Upstate New York Synod, allows for a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 9 board members in addition to the 4 officers. Nominations with bios are appreciated in advance, but nominations may be made from the floor as long as a bio is available.

We hope for representation from all areas of the state. This is easier now that most meetings are via Zoom with an occasional meeting in Syracuse. The Board meets every 4 months or so depending on what needs to be discussed and/or for convention planning.

All our Board member terms are up in 2023 as these dedicated women have been serving all through COVID. These positions include president, vice president, secretary and treasurer.
