Here are a few ways to participate this Fall...we look forward to seeing you!

Sunday morning worship at 8:55am is for all ages! Throughout September, you'll hear more about the theme "YOU MATTER!" and we are fed weekly around God's table of grace. **Would you like to share your gifts in worship?** You could be an acolyte or an usher. You could provide technical help with the Livestream Team. You could bring bread or wine for communion. There are too many options to list! Let the pastors know how you would like to serve.

Worship for Kids for ages 3 through 2nd grade resumes Sunday, September 7th! This group shares in a time of hearing the Word and participates in fun and conversation in an age-appropriate way! Parents can remain in the sanctuary while this group gathers in the room across the hall from the side entrance to the sanctuary. Children will return during the offering so they can participate in Communion.

JOY for kids in 3rd - 5th grade now meets **weekly!** JOY meets in their own room downstairs at the same time as Worship for Kids, beginning on **September 7th**. The structure of JOY builds on what is already familiar! This group will also return to worship during the offering in time to participate in communion.

Confirmation Ministry for Grades 6-8

BLC continues our confirmation partnership with St. Paul's, Pittsford again this year. The **Confirmation Kick-Off Dinner** will take place on **September 14**th at Bethlehem from 4:30pm – 6:30pm. - **Chancel Choir** (high school through adult) sings weekly in worship throughout the program year. Rehearsals are on Wednesdays from 7:30-9pm and begin on September 3rd.
